





1st HAPPY OR SAD

directions on back

YOU'LL NEED

Happy/Sad cross (1 per room)

Note: Happy/Sad cross has a happy face on front and a sad face on back.

2nd SAY WITH ME

all ages

Say Together: Jesus makes me God's friend because I believe He lives again!

3rd QUESTIONS

ages 4-K

- Why did Jesus choose to die on the cross?
 Because He loves everyone; because He wanted to make us right with God
- 2. We can believe in our heart that God raised someone from the dead. Who is it? Jesus



Say: Look at this. This cross is happy on one side ...

1. **Show** the happy side.

Say: ... and it's sad on the other.

2. **Show** the sad side.

Say: Some things about Jesus' cross are happy, and some are sad. I'll tell you something special about Jesus' cross, and you tell me if it's happy or sad.

- 3. Read one item from the Happy or Sad List.
- Kids choose if the item you read is happy or sad.
- After kids choose, **show** the happy side of the cross if it's happy or the sad side of the cross if it's sad.

Happy or Sad List

- Dying on the cross hurt Jesus. Sad
- Jesus took away EVERYONE'S sins. Hαρργ
- Jesus was punished for EVERYONE'S sins. Sad
- Jesus made me friends with God. Happy
- Jesus died. Sad
- Jesus came to life again. Happy
- Jesus died on the cross because He loves EVERYONE. Happy
- 6. Say "Say With Me" listed on the front.
- 7. For ages 4-K, **ask** "Questions" listed on the front.







1st ERASE SINS

directions on back

YOU'LL NEED

• Giant pencil (1 per room)

2nd SAY WITH ME

all ages

Say Together: Jesus makes me God's friend because I believe He lives again!

3rd QUESTIONS

ages 4-K

- How do sins make us feel inside? Yucky, sad, bad, mad, etc.
- 2. Who can erase our sins and take them away? *Jesus*



. Hold up pencil for kids to see.

Say: Look at this big pencil! I can write big with it!

2. Pretend to write with the pencil.

Say: And, I can take the writing away with the big eraser.

3. **Pretend to erase** what you wrote.

Say: Yep. Now what I wrote is all gone! That makes me think of Jesus! He erases sins out of our hearts. Tell me some bad sins we might choose to do.

4. Let kids **respond**. Examples: not sharing, yelling, hitting, disobeying, throwing a fit, etc.

Say: Yuck. Those are sins! How does that sin make our hearts feel?

5. Kids **respond.** Sad, sinful, grumpy, etc.

Say: Oh no! That sin has made our hearts sad.

 Lead kids to place hands on their hearts and make sad faces.

Say: Let's ask Jesus to forgive us!

- 7. Say together, "Jesus, please forgive my sins!"
- 8. Wave eraser over kids while they speak.

Say: Friends, when you ask Jesus to forgive you, He erases those sins right out of our hearts!

- Make happy faces and say together, "Thank you, Jesus!"
- 10. Say "Say With Me" listed on the front.
- 11. For ages 4-K, **ask** "Questions" listed on the front.







1st HAPPY HEART

directions on back

YOU'LL NEED

Giant heart bandage (1 per room)

2nd SAY WITH ME

all ages

Say Together: Jesus makes me God's friend because I believe He lives again!

3rd QUESTIONS

ages 4-K

- What do sins and wrong choices do to our hearts? Make them yucky, sad, broken, etc.
- Who can make our hearts all better when we ask Him to? Jesus



Say: Friends, I've been thinking about bad choices I made. It makes me sad and breaks my heart! Who can forgive me and make my heart all better again?

- 1. Kid answer. Jesus!
- 2. Show giant heart bandage to kids.

Say: Yes! Jesus can heal my heart! His grace is like a bandage that makes my heart all better.

3. Celebrate together.

Say: Let's play a game. When I hide this bandage, freeze and make a sad face. If I show the bandage, jump up and say, "Jesus makes me God's friend!"

- 4. **Show** the bandage and **help** kids **jump up** and **say**, "Jesus makes me God's friend!"
- 5. **Hide** the bandage behind your back and **help** kids **fall down** and **freeze**.
- 6. Repeat steps 4-5 as time allows.
- 7. Say "Say With Me" listed on the front.
- 8. For ages 4-K, **ask** "Questions" listed on the front.





A HAPPY SUNDAY

1st EMPTY TOMB

directions on back

YOU'LL NEED

Tomb flip card (1 per room)

2nd SAY WITH ME

all ages

Say Together: Jesus makes me God's friend because I believe He lives again!

3rd QUESTIONS

ages 4-K

- Where did they put Jesus' body after He died?
 In a tomb
- 2. Why wasn't Jesus in the tomb three days later? God made Jesus alive again.



1. Hold up the closed side of the tomb flip card.

Say: Look, friends. This is a tomb. It's a cave they put Jesus' body in when He died on the cross. Everyone was very sad.

2. Make a sad face together.

Say: After three days, the angels rolled the stone away. Let's see what was in the tomb after three days!

3. **Count to three** together and **flip** the card to the side showing the empty tomb.

Say: Wow! Jesus isn't in the tomb anymore! It's empty because God made Jesus alive again! Let's play again!

- 4. Show closed tomb picture, help kids crouch down, and count to three.
- 5. Flip card to the empty tomb, and help kids jump up and shout, "Jesus is alive again!"
- 6. **Repeat** steps 4-5 as time allows. **Choose** different kids to hold and flip the card each time.
- 7. Say "Say With Me" listed on the front.
- 8. For ages 4-K, **ask** "Questions" listed on the front.







EMPTY EGG 1st

directions on back

YOU'LL NEED

- Plastic eggs (5 per room) Crown (1 per room)
- Cross (1 per room)
- Pebble (1 per room)
- Nail (1 per room)

SAY WITH ME

all ages

Say Together: Jesus makes me God's friend because I believe He lives again!

QUESTIONS

ages 4-K

- Is Jesus dead or alive? Alive
- 2. What is special about Easter? It's the day Jesus came back to life!



Before Prop Talk

- Fill eggs with items.
- 2. Leave one egg empty. Save it to open last.

Prop Talk

Hold up the first egg and shake it.

Say: Do you hear that? What's inside this egg?

- 2. **Open** egg, **show** what's inside, and **use** the Resurrection Egg List below to talk about it.
- 3. Continue shaking, opening, and talking about eggs until only the empty one is left.
- 4. Shake the empty egg.

Say: Oh, my! This egg isn't making any noise!

- Open empty egg, act surprised, and show it.
- 6. **Say:** This egg shows Jesus isn't in the tomb anymore! Jesus isn't dead! Jesus is alive!
- 7. Say "Say With Me" listed on the front.
- 8. For ages 4-K, ask "Questions" listed on the front.

Resurrection Eggs List

- Cross: Jesus died on this to take the punishment for our sins and make us friends with God.
- Nail: They put nails in Jesus' hands when they put Him on the cross. It hurt Him, and it was sad.
- Crown of Thorns: They put this on Jesus' head when they nailed Him to the cross. It hurt a lot.
- Pebble: They put Jesus' body in a cave called a tomb and closed it with a big rock for a door.
